THIS GUIDE IS FOR...

Photo booths, bouncy castles, casino tables, magicians, circus performers, lawn games, live artists, entertainment extras - and pretty much anything else wonderful you are bringing to the day.

THE SHORT VERSION

Keep it simple, safe and easy.

Arrive at the agreed time, set up in the agreed place, look after your own equipment and take everything away afterwards. Normal modest electrical use is absolutely fine - if your setup needs anything unusual, just let us know beforehand.

If in doubt, ask. We would always rather sort something beforehand than on the day.

A FEW SIMPLE THINGS

Working at Moonacre

Moonacre is a small countryside venue with a small on-site team. We want suppliers to have plenty of freedom to do what they do best - these notes just help the site stay safe, tidy and easy for everyone.

Power - most setups are nice and simple

Modest electrical use from a normal 13A supply is generally fine. If your setup includes high-powered heating, large motors, substantial lighting, multiple high-draw items or needs anything beyond a normal socket, please tell us in advance.

01

Arrival & setup

- Please arrive at the time agreed with the couple and set up in the location allocated for you.
- Larger equipment can usually be dropped closer to the event area, but vehicles should then be moved to the main car park.
- Please check with us before driving onto grass, particularly if the ground is soft.

03

Ground fixings

- If your setup needs stakes, pegs or ground anchors - especially inflatables or larger installations - please agree the position with Moonacre before anything is driven into the ground.
- This helps us protect underground services and choose a suitable location.

Weather & outdoors

- Outdoor suppliers should come prepared for the conditions and make sure equipment is securely installed and suitable for the weather.
- If conditions become unsafe, Moonacre may ask for an activity or installation to pause or close.

02

Equipment & safety

- You are responsible for the safe setup, operation and supervision of your own equipment and activity.
- Please keep walkways, exits and guest routes clear, and make sure cables or equipment do not create trip hazards.
- Any relevant inspection, certification, risk assessment or insurance for your activity should be in place and available if requested.

04

Sound, heat & effects

- Please let us know beforehand about amplified sound, generators, smoke or haze, open flames, heating equipment or any unusual effects.
- This does not mean they are automatically a problem - we just need to know what is coming onto site.

06

Pack-down

- Please remove your equipment, packaging and supplier waste after the event unless another collection arrangement has been agreed.
- Our team is small, so please do not rely on Moonacre staff to move, dismantle, supervise or store supplier equipment.

AND THAT'S REALLY IT

Come prepared, leave the space as you found it, and give us a shout beforehand if your setup is a little out of the ordinary. We look forward to having you here.
