A few useful bits

We're pretty laid back with photographers. There are no prescribed photo spots - explore, use the light and capture the day in the way that works best for the couple.

Bertie at sunset

Evening shots on the hill by Bertie the Bus are brilliant for catching the sunset.

Woodland

After the ceremony, the woodland chairs are removed and the space works beautifully for afternoon photos.

Bluebells

In April and May, bluebells can usually be found in the woods near the Treehouse.

Arrival & parking

- Please park in the main car park.
- If you have larger equipment, you are welcome to drop it at the marquee first and then move your vehicle to the car park.
- Please avoid driving onto grassed areas unless a member of the Moonacre team has said it is okay.

Sparklers

- If the couple is having sparklers, these are done ONLY around the fire pit.
- Please work with the coordinator or Moonacre team on timing and positioning.

Batteries & equipment

- There is somewhere to charge camera batteries during the day - please speak to a member of the bar team and they will point you in the right direction.
- Normal flash and portable lighting are absolutely fine.
- Please keep stands, bags and cables clear of walkways and fire exits.

Drone photography

- If you are planning to fly a drone, please let us know beforehand.
- The operator remains responsible for flying safely and legally and for any insurance or permissions required.
